

Monthly Meeting Notes  
October 14, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM by President Tim Hurd.

Secretary's report was read by Sandra Hurd. Motion to file as reported was made by Richard Biggio, motion 2nd by Rhonda Orchowski.

Treasurers Report was given by Sandra Hurd. Sandra will check with the bank regarding a charge that was made against the account by the bank. Motion to file to audit was made by Tim Hurd, motion 2nd by Wayne Evans.

League Report Outs:

Rimfire (Richard Biggio): Richard turned in shooters fee from previous 2 months along with a membership. Reported that the league has had a mixed attendance. He also has purchased targets for the league. Reported that they are seeing saw dust again inside the range house indicating that we may have carpenter ants or bees. Will treat in the spring.

Archery (Wayne Evans): Wayne reported that the PennYork league meeting will be held on 10/28 to wrap up this year and plan the 2019 season. Our club ranked 4th out of the 6 clubs participating for 2018. The club has 43 targets which are in good shape, a few will need new inserts or minor repairs. Wayne is looking to purchase a couple new/replacement targets and turned in an estimate from Barrett's.

New Business:

The club donated \$500 to flood victim for help in replacing furnace.

The club grounds were flooded and a clean up day was scheduled, Thank you to Tim Hurd, Dan King, Leland Petrey and Randy Jones for the tremendous job they did cleaning things up.

Joseph Orchowski brought up that we will need to winterize the lawn mower soon. There is a filter and oil already purchased in the garage. Joe will take care of cleaning the mower up and prepping for winter.

Rhonda Orchowski requested \$200 to be used in purchasing items for the Helping Hands Organization. This group provides Christmas gifts for needy families in the valley. Rhonda will use the money to purchase blankets for the organization to distribute as needed. Motion to donate to the cause was made Wayne Evans, motion 2nd by Richard Biggio.

Rhonda Orchowski also brought up that the flooding in the area washed out all the rocks from the steel barrier along the bank beside the club. The DEP (Williamsport) will need to be contacted to request fill.

Richard Biggio requested that the club purchase some additional homasote for backers. Motion to purchase was made by Tim Hurd, motion 2nd by Sandra Hurd.

Wayne Evans requested money to purchase replacement targets/inserts for archery. Tim made a motion to purchase the targets not to exceed set budget of \$1900, motion 2nd by Sandra Hurd.

Question was raised by Wayne regarding liability insurance and coverage for archery set up and league shooting. Wayne will review the current policy and will discuss at next meeting as to whether or not we are sufficiently covered for all activities. Sandra will email Wayne the current policy.
